

» CASE STUDY 308

ULCERATION, RIGHT 5TH TOE :

DATE : February 2001

PATIENT : 55 year-old Caucasian female

MEDICAL HISTORY :

Non-diabetic, non-compromised patient self-treated with chemically impregnated corn pads. Patient presented with localized inflammation and discharge from beneath the hyperkeratotic tissue

TREATMENT :

Sharp debridement of the necrotic tissue revealed an ulcer penetrating to the joint capsule. Started on daily dressing changes with AmeriGel® Wound Dressing. (Fig. 1A)

RESULTS :

Ulcer considered healed in one week. (Fig. 1B)
